**3 Roads Communications Wins 3 Aurora Awards**

***For The Love Of Their Brother***

3 Roads Communications has just been awarded three Aurora Awards for ***For The Love Of Their Brother***, a thirty minute documentary about a 9/11 hero and his family. ***For the Love of Their Brother*** also recently garnered four Telly Awards.

2005 Aurora Awards for ***For The Love Of Their Brother*** were awarded in the following categories:

- Platinum Best of Show for Documentary-Biography.
- Platinum Best of Show for Use of Music
- Gold Award for Use of Drama

The Aurora Awards is an international competition designed to recognize excellence in the film and video industries. The Aurora Awards recognizes those who have captivated audiences with the displays produced from their own creative forces.

“The new Aurora Awards, along with four Telly Awards, is extraordinary praise for our tribute to Stephen Siller and the heroes of September 11<sup>th</sup>,” said Russ Hodge, President of 3 Roads Communications. “We hope that audiences who see ***For The Love Of Their Brother*** this fall will be uplifted and inspired.” added Mr. Hodge.

***For The Love Of Their Brother***, is a half-hour, heartwarming story about the Siller family who lost their youngest brother, a firefighter, on 9/11. The older siblings had raised Stephen Siller, who was orphaned at age 10, and now they are continuing their legacy of love by their annual "Tunnel to Towers Run," which follows the route Stephen took when the off-duty firefighter grabbed his gear and ran through the blocked Brooklyn Battery Tunnel to get to the World Trade Center, where he subsequently perished. His story has become legend in the newsrooms and

firehouses of New York City. The program is hosted by celebrated actor John Turturro.
